4. First-aid measures

Inhalation:	Move person to fresh air. If coughing, irritation, dizziness, or breathing difficulty develops or persists, obtain medical attention.

5. Fire-fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media:	Use water spray, dry chemical, carbon dioxide, or foam suitable for the surrounding fire.
Unsuitable extinguishing media:	No specific restriction identified. Avoid a high-pressure water stream if it may spread spilled material.
Specific hazards:	The product is not classified as flammable from the supplied composition. Closed containers may rupture when heated. Thermal decomposition may produce carbon oxides, nitrogen oxides, hydrogen chloride, and irritating fumes.

6. Accidental release measures

Accidental Release Measures:	For small spills, wipe up with a mop, cloth or suitable absorbent material. For larger spills, use sand or other inert absorbents. Do not use a vacuum system. Do not flush with water or allow product to enter water systems.

7. Handling and storage

Handling:	Avoid direct contact with eyes and prolonged skin contact. Avoid breathing excessive spray or mist. Use with adequate ventilation. Wear eye protection and gloves during bulk manufacturing, filling and spill cleanup. Keep containers closed when not in use.
Storage:	Store tightly closed in a cool, dry and well-ventilated location. Protect from excessive heat and freezing. Keep away from strong oxidizing materials.

Wear suitable chemical-resistant gloves during bulk handling or cleanup. Avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact. Wash hands thoroughly after handling.
