4. First-aid measures

Description of necessary first-aid measures

Inhalation:	Inhalation exposure is not expected during normal use because the product is a nonvolatile, lotion-like cream. If mist or heated vapor is inhaled and discomfort occurs, move the person to fresh air. Obtain medical attention if symptoms persist.
Skin Contact:	The product is intended for external skin contact when used as directed. If irritation or an allergic reaction occurs, discontinue use and wash the affected area with soap and water. Obtain medical advice if symptoms persist.
Eye Contact:	Rinse cautiously with clean water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Obtain medical advice if irritation persists.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by medical personnel or a poison-control center. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Contact a physician or poison-control center if a significant amount is swallowed or symptoms occur.
Most important symptoms/effects:	Direct eye contact may cause temporary redness, tearing or discomfort. Sensitive individuals may experience skin irritation or an allergic response.
Immediate medical attention and special treatment:	Treat symptomatically. No specific antidote is known.

5. Fire-fighting measures

Specific hazards:	The finished product is a water-based, lotion-like cream and is not expected to be readily combustible under normal conditions. Prolonged heating may evaporate the water content and leave combustible organic material.

Hazardous combustion products:	Carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide, smoke and irritating organic vapors.

6. Accidental release measures

Personal precautions:	Spilled cream may make floors and work surfaces slippery. Avoid direct eye contact. Wear suitable gloves and eye protection when cleaning a large spill.
Cleanup methods:	Contain the spill. Scoop, scrape or wipe up the bulk material and place it in a suitable container. Absorb remaining residue with an inert absorbent material. Wash the affected surface with detergent and water. Clean and dry the floor thoroughly because a slippery residue may remain.
Environmental precautions:	Prevent large quantities from entering storm drains, surface waters or soil.

7. Handling and storage

Handling:	Use in accordance with product directions. Avoid direct eye contact. Do not ingest. Avoid generating aerosols or mists. Wash hands after handling. Keep containers closed when not in use. Clean spills promptly to prevent slipping.
Storage:	Store in the original, tightly closed container in a cool, dry and well-ventilated location. Protect from freezing, excessive heat and direct sunlight.
Storage temperature:	Room temperature.
Incompatible materials:	Strong oxidizing agents.

Control Parameters

Exposure Limits:	Oil mist, mineral: OSHA PEL: 5 mg/m ³ , 8-hour time-weighted average This exposure limit applies to airborne mineral-oil mist. Airborne mineral-oil mist is not expected during ordinary application of the finished cream.
Engineering Controls:	General room ventilation is normally adequate. Local exhaust ventilation may be necessary if the product is heated, sprayed or processed in a manner that generates airborne mist.
